



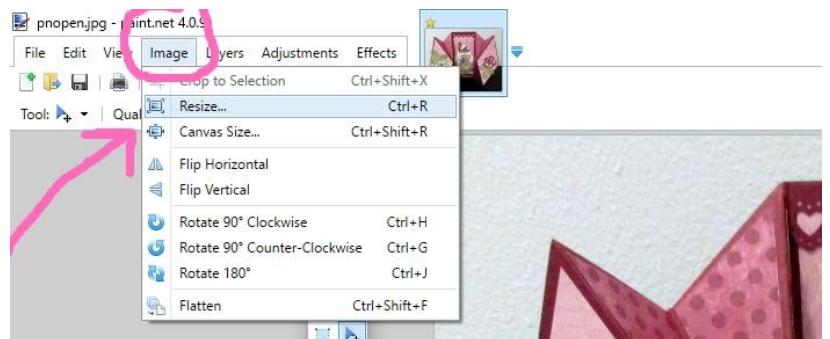
Adding a watermark in Paint.net



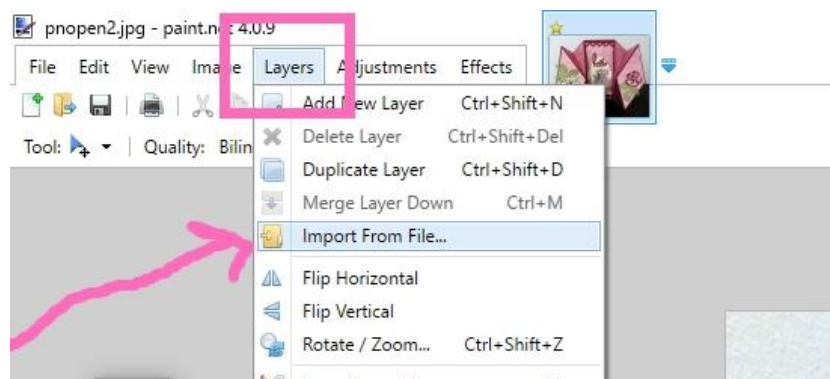
1. Open your card in Paint.Net.... you can do this by going up to the top navigation bar and clicking on FILE > OPEN > a new window opens allowing you to find and select where your photo is stored.



2. Again, go up to top nav bar and click IMAGE > RESIZE > change width to 650 pixels.



3. Next Click on LAYERS > IMPORT FILE > and choose your watermark



4. It should have placed your watermark onto your photo with a running box around it and in bottom right corner you'll see a tiny white box, click and hold that while you drag it



into position (wherever on your card you want it.) Then you can resize your watermark if it's too large, like in my photo. To do that, while the running box is still around the watermark, hold down the SHIFT button while clicking on a corner indicator (circle or arrow) of your watermark and drag the indicator inward to make it smaller. You might have to move it back into position after you resize it.

5. You can Deselect the watermark when you are done. To do that, just go up to the icon bar and click on the Deselect icon. If you hover, it will tell you what it is. Here's a picture of it.



6. FILE > SAVE AS > name your new photo! 😊

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
